Lloyd's has a duty under the Lloyd's Act 1982 and the Register of Members' Byelaw (No 22) of 1983 to maintain details of Working and Non-Underwriting Working Members in a central Working Members' Register (The Register).

The Register is used to determine who is eligible to vote in the election of External and Working members of the Council of Lloyd's, it is important therefore that the details of those members recorded in the Register are regularly reviewed and updated as appropriate.

Members' Services Unit will shortly contact each broker, members' agent and managing agent who are recorded as employing working members (including non-underwriting working members) to seek verification of the employment status of those members who are currently recorded in the Register.
