Summary:

Lloyd's would like to invite all market participants to an event to commemorate the role played by Lloyd's members in WWI and WWII and to unveil a new war memorial on Wednesday, 2 July between 11:00 and 12:00.

To mark the occasion, His Royal Highness the Duke of Gloucester and Chairman Lord Levene will unveil the new memorial, and the Bishop of London will officiate at the dedication. The three Armed Forces will parade with the Band of the Blues and Royals and the State Trumpeters.

How this will affect you:

The Lutine Bell will be rung at 11am to commence the ceremony and those in the market are encouraged to make their way to Leadenhall Street via Tower 1. There will also be a minute silence at 11.50am.

There will be major road closures and local disruption throughout the morning and lunchtime of Wednesday 2 July. Access to and from the London Lloyd's building will also be restricted throughout this period.
