## Background

Lloyd's market bulletin Y4182, dated 17 September 2008, refers to Lloyd's aggregate reporting, on behalf of the Lloyd's market, in respect of Hurricane Ike claims data.

The Texas Department of Insurance, where requesting claims data in respect of previous hurricane events, has required this data to be split between affected geographical territories by Texas county, and we anticipate this requirement applying to Hurricane Ike claims.

## Hurricane Ike Claims – current list of counties

Market bulletin Y4182 requires Lloyd's brokers and managing agents to provide a split at county level when Hurricane Ike claims files are presented to XCS. In response to enquiries received from the market and to assist in identifying the geographic scope of this requirement, it can be confirmed that the county level splits should be provided in respect of the 33 counties included in the Texas disaster declaration.

The counties included in the Texas disaster declaration are as follows; Angelina, Austin, Brazoria, Brazos, Chambers, Cherokee, Fort Bend, Galveston, Gregg, Grimes, Hardin, Harris, Houston, Jasper, Jefferson, Liberty, Madison, Matagorda, Montgomery, Nacogdoches, Newton, Orange, Polk, Rusk, Sabine, San Augustine, San Jacinto, Trinity, Tyler, Walker, Waller, Washington and Wharton.

Lloyd's will issue further guidance should the scope of this requirement change in response to bulletins issued by the Texas Department of Insurance.
