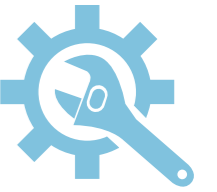


Lloyd's Charities Trust will support international disaster relief charity RedR UK to deliver the 'Ready to Respond programme' until March 2019, with the aim of increasing the ability of individuals and organisations involved in humanitarian action to prepare for and respond to emergencies, especially in urban centres.

Lloyd's Charities Trust will be supporting RedR UK to:

- develop the skills of local responders in disaster-affected communities through developing and delivering a new e-facilitated learning programme;
- subsidise face to face training for international aid workers;
- address the technical challenges faced in disasters by providing online technical support and harnessing the expertise of the private sector; and
- provide tailored support in the immediate aftermath of a disaster through a contingency fund.

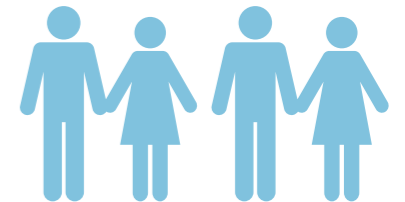
